Are you looking for a way to make a difference in the lives of our global neighbors and put your faith into action? Travel to Cambodia with Habitat Wake to build homes and experience the richness of the country's culture.

Habitat Wake's next global trip to Cambodia is **January 17-27, 2019**. The trip is organized in partnership with Habitat for Humanity of Cambodia.

More than a quarter of Cambodia's 15 million residents live below the poverty line. Habitat for Humanity's goal is to break the cycle of poverty by providing safe and affordable housing solutions. During the mission trip, you will experience the exhilaration of working with a team of people who are called to serve. You will have time to reflect, recharge and enjoy an escape into the Cambodian culture. With daily devotions and meaningful discussions, the trip is designed to enable participants to grow in their faith and gain new insights into global poverty.

Habitat Wake has a special relationship with Habitat Cambodia. Amidst rapid local growth, we expanded our global support in 2015 to include Cambodia and Malawi, while continuing our support for Honduras. Advancing Habitat's global work is an integral part of Habitat Wake's mission.

CAMBODIA TRIP HIGHLIGHTS

ESTIMATED PROGRAM COST

\$1,200 USD (Does not include airfare, required visas or immunizations.) The program cost includes accommodations, meals, in-country transportation and medical insurance, as well as an important donation to Habitat for Humanity to help build safe, affordable housing. Participants are responsible for their air transportation to Cambodia. Information on suggested flights will be provided.

ITINERARY

Saturday: Arrive in Cambodia by 4:00 p.m. and enjoy your first in-country, team dinner

Sunday: Orientation and free time or cultural activity TBD

Monday – Thursday: Build each day with free time or team activities in the evenings. We may also participate in some advocacy activities with the Habitat for Humanity Cambodia team.

Friday: Complete construction, then enjoy a farewell celebration with the community

Saturday: Cultural activities TBD

Sunday: Continue your trip independently or depart for home

TASKS ON THE WORK SITE

Mission trip team members may work in a variety of construction jobs. Responsibilities will likely include making bricks, layering bricks, compacting dirt, moving materials, mixing concrete as well as other tasks assigned by the construction supervisor.

ACCOMMODATIONS AND MEALS

Our team will stay in a hotel with two to four people per room. Breakfast will be served at the hotel, lunch will be provided at the work site and dinner will be served at a variety of local restaurants. Snacks, such as fruit, and plenty of water will be available on the build site during breaks.
