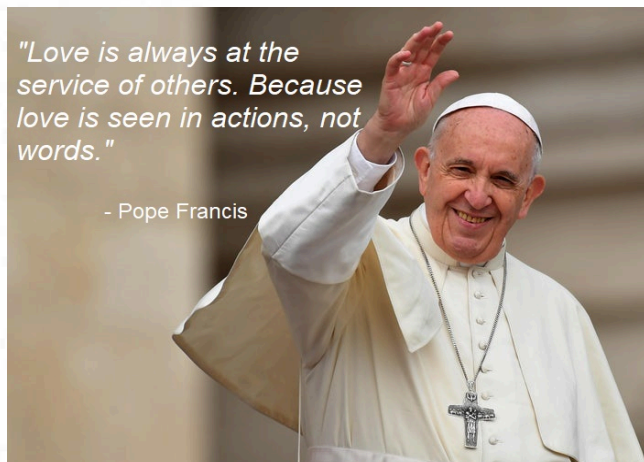

## "Habi Facts"

- Habitat for Humanity is a Christian ministry that operates in every state in the USA and in 70 countries around the world.
- Habitat Wake has served approximately 1,000 families since forming in 1985, and is one of the largest Habitat affiliates in the country.
- 1 in 4 families lack safe, affordable housing in Wake and Johnston counties.
- Habitat Wake built 83 homes, repaired 66 homes and funded 125 homes globally in fiscal 2019.
- Habitat Wake tithes to support Habitat's work in Honduras, Cambodia and Malawi and regularly sends teams to those countries.
