UNC REX Healthcare celebrates 125 years and dedicates new home with a Habitat homeowner family

RALEIGH, NC (July xx, 2019) -- On Thursday, Aug. 1, UNC REX Healthcare will celebrate the completion of a new, affordable Habitat home. The dedication will be held in the Crosstowne neighborhood of Southeast Raleigh:

In honor of its 125th anniversary, UNC REX donated \$50,000 to build a Habitat home. During the 11-week build, nearly 200 UNC REX employees spent 1,400 volunteer hours building the home alongside the homeowner.
