Habitat Wake kicks off Kenly build on September 7

KENLY, NC (Aug.16, 2019) – This year Habitat for Humanity of Wake County (serving Wake and Johnston counties) is building new single-family homes in Kenly and invites the community to volunteer onsite at the build kick-off on Saturday, September 7th.

Habitat Wake and Habitat Johnston became one organization in January 2018, and Habitat Wake's goal is to eventually build five homes a year in Johnston County. In addition to Clayton, Habitat Wake has also built homes in Selma, and now Kenly.

In addition to volunteers, Habitat Wake is seeking homeowners in Johnston County. More than 19,000 families in Johnston County lack affordable housing. To be considered "affordable," housing expenses must be less than 30 percent of a family's household income. Habitat Wake serves families from all walks of life, so anyone who has interest should apply.
