### What is Habitat Wake?

- Seeking to put God's love into action, Habitat for Humanity of Wake County brings people together to build homes, communities, and hope.
- Habitat for Humanity which operates in 70 countries and has served approximately 40 million families.
- Habitat Wake was formed in 1985.
- Habitat Johnston County was formed in 1991 and merged with Habitat Wake in 2018.
- Habitat Wake has built more than 900 new homes and served nearly 2,000 families
- In FY25, we will build 44 new homes, preserve 80 homes, and help many more families through our advocacy efforts.
- Habitat Wake tithes on its unrestricted income in Honduras, Malawi, and Cambodia.
- Habitat Wake's homes aren't given away

# Build We need qualified homebuyers

To **qualify** for a Habitat Home, you must be able to say **yes** to these questions:

- ☐ Have you lived or worked in Wake or Johnston County for the past 12 months?
- Do you have a valid Social Security Number?
- ☐ Have you maintained a steady income for the past 24 months?
- ☐ Are you a U.S. citizen or permanent resident?
- Do you have reasonably good credit?
- □ Do you have a good rental history?



# Build We need qualified homebuyers

Do you have an annual gross income (before taxes and deductions) within the amounts listed?

Another key criteria is the ability to afford 70% of the appraised value of a home currently in our inventory.


The pre-application step helps determine your affordability based on your income and debt-to-income ratio.

1	\$68,500
2	\$78,250
3	\$88,050
4	\$97,800
5	\$105,650
6	\$113,450

### Wins

- Acquisition and Rezoning for 5 lots in Wendell
- Affordable Knightdale Plan passed
- Wake County increased the allocation for the Affordable Housing Development Program (AHDP) by \$4.5 million
