

# **Homeownership Selection Coordinator**

### SUMMARY:

The Homeownership Selection Coordinator (HSC) will assist with the recruitment, processing, and selection of homeowner families.

This is a Full Time Non-Exempt position requiring flexibility to work evening and weekend hours as needed for meetings and projects. The HSC will likely spend on average at least five days per week, Monday – Friday (40 hour work week with 8 hours days).

### **ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:**

- Assist Homeownership staff in responding to calls and emails inquiring about applicant status in a timely manner.
- Assist with partner family recruitment process;
- Report on quality and quantity of applicant pool;
- Assist families in the completion of the housing application;
- Assist with homeowner selection process;
- Manage new Salesforce process funnel;
- Review online pre-applications and send appropriate acknowledgement;
- Assist HSM with applicant information and application sessions;
- Track and screen applicants before submitting to Homeowner Selection Manager;
- Set appropriate timelines to notify families of their status in timely manner through automated messages;
- Maintain applicant files; keep records of specific issues on file; and
- Prepare applicant files for HSM review

## KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES REQUIRED:

- Excellent computer skills including data bases, Excel, MS Word, **Salesforce** and Google products.
- Ability to efficiently and effectively organize work and time. Ability to work in an office with frequent interruptions. Must be a self-starter.
- Current driver's license and vehicle
- Ability to establish and maintain excellent working relationships with Habitat Wake staff, partner families, neighborhood residents, and partner organizations.
