Shack-A-Thon is a student-run fundraiser that started at NC State in 1998 with one shack and a few passionate students wanting to bring awareness to the issue of affordable housing. It has since grown to include more than 20 shacks, dozens of student organizations, and thousands of participating students each year. Shack-A-Thon raises money to support Habitat for Humanity of Wake County and its efforts to provide affordable housing for people in need.

From **March 29 – April 4** students will eat, sleep and fundraise in more than 20 unique student designed and built shacks on Wolf Plaza. Shack-A-Thon is one of the largest and most successful fundraisers at NC State and receives extensive media coverage from local TV, newspapers, blogs, Twitter feeds, Instagram and Facebook posts.

## What will you be sponsoring?

All funds raised from sponsors, shacks, and the student body will be used to build a new, affordable Habitat home during the 2024-2025 fiscal year in Wake County. Habitat for Humanity of Wake County builds safe, low cost, high quality houses for qualified homebuyers. Each home is built in partnership with sponsors, volunteers, and homeowner families. The houses are safe, affordable, and are sold for no profit to the partner family, who repays a very affordable mortgage.

Homeowners attend a series of workshops on financial literacy and home maintenance so that they are well prepared to responsibly care for their homes and families. They are also required to invest 200 'sweat equity' hours by volunteering at the build sites of their home and the homes of others in the home buyer program. Habitat for Humanity focuses on building and empowering families to break the cycle of poverty, which is a powerful stimulus to the local economy and benefits local companies like yours.

## Companies

A check written for the corresponding amount must arrive at the Habitat for Humanity of Wake County Raleigh Office by **March 1, 2026** in order to have your sponsorship level completely fulfilled.

If a sponsorship level is chosen within a week of the deadline, personally dropping off the check at Habitat Wake is required (2420 North Raleigh Boulevard, Raleigh, NC 27604).
